- d) Condition of footpath between Aislaby and Wrelton along northern side of A170. *Continuing to monitor.*
- e) Drainage ditch on Marton Lane/Street Lane with no safety barrier *Still to be reported*

Noted that the badly-damaged traveller caravans stood on Nova Lane have been removed. Streetscene to be notified and asked to remove remaining rubbish.

11. The correspondence from BT regarding the removal of both the telephone landline and the telephone 'red box' from Wrelton, Main St. was discussed following informal correspondence prior to the meeting. It was decided to object to both removals on grounds of call numbers and quality of mobile signal in the village. Should this appeal fail, it was felt that the phone box should be retained as 'street furniture'. An email with this information was sent to North Yorkshire Council (Alice Downham) from the meeting, as the deadline for comment was 30.04.25, although BTs deadline is in June. Item to be added to next meeting agenda for further discussion.

Cllr. Taylor commented on the width of the footpath on the north side of the A170 through Aislaby and the absence of one on the south side in both Aislaby and Middleton by the garage. He was told of the efforts of the Parish Counsil to clear the footpath on the north side and it was agreed to discuss other points at the next meeting, especially in light of the letter from Cllr. Greg White detailed in item 10a above.
