Of the ordinary meeting of the Aislaby, Middleton and Wrelton Parish council held at Wrelton Village Hall on Tuesday 28th October 2025 at 7:30pm

9. General Maintenance/Villages.

a) Street lighting issues and repairs progress. – *Noted that light 2 (Cawthorne Lane outside Wrelton Village Hall) has finally been re-instated with LED lamp. Still one lamp on High St. to replace and two concrete columns to remove in Wrelton plus one lamp to replace in Aislaby.*
b) Japanese Knotweed in Beadale Wood. – *Re-monitor in Spring.*
c) Condition of footpath between Aislaby and Wrelton along northern side of A170. – *Condition to be monitored.*

- d) Overgrown hedge on Costa Lane Middleton Millenium Wood. (ref: 101011195184) -

Cllr. Taylor informed the councillors that 'Safer Spaces' campaign on possible release of funding from the combined authority mayor's travel budget in January 2026.

11. To receive reports from Councillors on delegated matters.

- a) No further information regarding the status refused retrospective listed building application for Pear Tree Villa, Wrelton
- b) No further information regarding 'Cameras for NY'.
- c) Aislaby notice board repair. After looking at the cost of replacing the current board, it was decided that a refurbishment and repaint would be more cost-effective.
- d) Having had no negative feedback/declarations of ownership of the current benches in Wrelton, plus approval of the Village Hall committee to replace them, the two newer benches offered will be sited in their place.
Thanks are offered to Cllr. Baird and Mr. Bojas for their repair of the third Wrelton village bench, on the corner of Cawthorne Ave., which the Council were not aware of needing repair.
- e) The stile near Wrelton Caravan park has been notified to 'Paths' at NYC. The notification has been acknowledged with a case number. Whilst reporting this stile, two more stiles (on the path to Sinnington) and the gate to the field at the top of Beadale Wood, all broken or unsafe, have also been reported and case numbers issued against.
