Chairman's Report 2025

The council currently has one missing councillor for the Middleton Parish. Two new councillors have been co-opt'd this year one for Aislaby Parish and one for Middleton Parish.

Several village projects have been achieved during the year. The council has financed additional grass and hedge cutting beside footpaths and lanes, re-build then culvert wall on Marton lane and repaired the footpath steps in Wrelton.

The council has also provided funding assistance through the grant scheme. These include defibrillator maintenance in Wrelton, Wrelton playground maintenance and Village green maintenance.

The council has continued to operate without a paid Clerk managing and sharing the work between councillors. This has allowed the Council finances to remain very healthy and the council continues to seek projects for the best use of these funds.
